Reports can be submitted 24/7 via:

Reports can be submitted online and via telephone

NOTE: Our school has contracted with a company called PublicSchoolWORKS to provide this service and to ensure you remain anonymous. If you use the telephone reporting system, the person you will be talking with is not affiliated with our district. The attendant will listen to your issue, complete a written report, and then, if you'd like, transfer you to a specialist or other support person.

- 2. Your issue will be investigated by someone at your school**
